High arm / corner seat box-1 box

1x High arm / corner seat


High arm and back box-1 box

## 2x Backs



1x Scatter cushion


First, let's assemble the low arm section.


Place arm on
left hand side.

## Turn seat up onto its side.


2.

Align brackets between the back and seat and slide back into place.

We recommend having one person slide the back piece on and the other holding the seat in place.

## Rotate 90 degrees and flip onto its side.

Arm brackets should be facing the ceiling on the side you would like the arms on.

4.

Align brackets between the arm and seat and slide arm into place.

We recommend having one person slide the arm piece on and the other holding the seat in place.


## 5.

This module is now assembled! Flip upright and set aside.


To assemble the right side, repeat steps $1-4$ but place the low arm on the right side.


Place arm on

right hand side.

## 6.

Rotate the brackets out.


Now let's assemble the middle section.

## Turn seat up onto its side.



## 8.

Align brackets between the back and seat and slide back into place.

We recommend having one person slide the arm piece on and the other holding the seat in place.


## 9.

Rotate 90 degrees to your left and rotate the brackets out.

10.

This module is now assembled! Flip upright and set aside.


Now let's assemble the corner section.


## Turn seat up onto its side.



## Align brackets between the high arm

 and seat and slide arm into place.We recommend having one person slide the high arm piece on and the other holding the seat in place.

Rotate 90 degrees and flip onto its side.

Brackets should be facing the ceiling.

Align brackets between the high arm and seat and slide arm into place.

We recommend having one person slide the high arm piece on and the other holding the seat in place.

15.

Rotate the brackets out.

16.

## This module is now assembled!

 Flip upright and set aside.

Choose where you would like your Everyday Sofa to live and then it's time to connect the modules together.

## Align connectors and push modules together.

These will click together and lock the pieces.
